

## Profile: Free State Project Member Brian Seaworth

## **Free State Project Members**

Free State Project members sign a pledge to move to New Hampshire and work to change the way of life in our state. They do not move here for a job, or for family, or even because they like what New Hampshire has to offer. Instead, they move here because a political group they are affiliated with voted on a state to move to in order to enact a political agenda, and New Hampshire was the unlucky recipient of that vote.

## State House Candidate Brian Seaworth (Merrimack District 20: Chichester & Pembroke)

State House candidate Brian Seaworth started to move his family to New Hampshire in late 2006. Seaworth has demonstrated considerable ties to the Free State Project, including:

- Seaworth and his wife Ieva are online members and supporters of the Free State Project. The Seaworth's are members of the Free State Project membership group on Facebook, 'like' the Free State Project online, and support Free Talk Live, a radio station for the Free State Project out of Keene. - Brian and Ieva Seaworth started purchase of their home in Pembroke in late 2006, and less than a year and a half later Brian ran for both the State House and the local Pembroke Planning Committee. - Brian Seaworth accepts bitcoin for campaign donations. Bitcoin is an alternative
  monetary system to the U.S. dollar. All but a few of the candidates running in New
