

Profile: Free State Project Member Robert Hull

Free State Project Members

Free State Project members sign a pledge to move to New Hampshire and work to change the way of life in our state. They do not move here for a job, or for family, or even because they like what New Hampshire has to offer. Instead, they move here because a political group they are affiliated with voted on a state to move to in order to enact a political agenda, and New Hampshire was the unlucky recipient of that vote.

State House Candidate Robert Hull (Grafton District 9: Alexandria, Ashland, Bridgewater, Bristol, Grafton)

State House candidate Robert Hull moved from New Jersey to New Hampshire in 2005 as part of the Free State Project. Hull has demonstrated considerable ties to the Free State Project, including:

- Hull signed the early mover pledge, which was aimed at getting 1,000 Free Staters to move to New Hampshire early to establish a network for other Free Staters to follow in later years. The majority of FSP participants will not move until 20,000 individuals have signed on for the Free State Project. [Free State Project. First 1,000 Pledge. 2003-2006]
- Hull is part of the Free Town Project that has attempted to take over the municipal government of the town of Grafton. The Free Town Project is an offshoot of the Free State Project, dedicated to a libertarian takeover of a small town. The goals of the Free Town Project are: "to liberate either a New Hampshire Town, or a Western County, by moving in enough Libertarians to control the local Government and remove oppressive Regulations (such as Planning & Zoning, and Building Code requirements) and stop enforcement of Laws prohibiting Victimless Acts among Consenting Adults, such as Dueling, Gambling, Incest, Price-Gouging, Cannibalism, and Drug Handling." - Hull bought several properties in Grafton to be used as a launching area for Free State Project activists who want to move to Grafton. [Concord Monitor. Libertarians set sights on Grafton. June 13, 2004]
- Residents at Hull's properties in Grafton are under investigation for voter fraud by the Attorney General's office. The supervisor of the checklist from Grafton said that the complaint that is currently under investigation is that multiple Free State Activists voted from Hull's residence who did not actually live there at the time. The ultra-extreme Free State Project voted on a state to move 20,000 people to, with the stated purpose to take over state government and dismantle it. The Free State Project seeks to create a libertarian "utopia" void of public infrastructure and common laws, and to use the power of

numbers to dramatically change New Hampshire – even threatening secession from the rest of the country. Members like Robert Hull are actively working to help the Free State Project fulfill those goals.
